

FAW First Aid at Work - 3 Day Course

Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work (RQF)

Who is this course for?

This First Aid at Work course is aimed at anyone who would like to become a fully qualified first aider at work, including employee's where an employers' first aid needs assessment identify the need for a qualified first aider in the workplace.

Course Content

This course is suitable for high risk environments and has a duration of 18hrs. The FAW First Aid at Work Course is recommended by the Health and Safety Executive (HSE). The course covers a wide range of topics and has a 3 part exam at the end. There is also an assessment and successful candidates are awarded a Qualified First Aider at Work Certificate, which is valid for 3 years.

- Types of burns and their treatment

- Bandaging
- Recovery Position
